Anthology is our attempt to build something sturdier. True solidarity isn't one voice or one tribe or one lane. It's a collection. Different stories. Different disciplines. Different kinds of work. All bound together by a shared responsibility.

- Parallel translations with interlinear Greek & Hebrew
